

BEFORE YOU START

This Quick Start Guide contains essential installation and startup instructions. Read the complete guide and all safety warnings before commencing installation.

A. Charging your Acorn 500

- Use a GFCI outlet, located at least 3.5 metres (11.5 feet) from the pool.
- Connect the charger and cable unit.
- Insert the plug into the GFCI outlet.
- Insert the other end of the cable into the charge socket at the rear of your acorn cleaner.

NOTE: DO NOT USE AN EXTENSION CORD! While the battery is charging, the light will be solid **RED**.

B. The Acorn App. While your new Acorn 500 is charging, please download














B. On cleaner LED indicator array



A solid **GREEN** light indicates the cleaner is fully charged and ready to use.


On startup, if the Power Status light is **RED**, then the cleaner is not fully charged.

B. Cleaning your pool with your new acorn 500.

The Acorn 500 has are four cleaning modes.

NOTE: These relate to the LED indicators as described above which will illuminate when a particular cleaning mode is selected.




This mode activates Acorn's innovative navigation technology, which automatically pairs the cleaner with the pool and configures the most suitable cleaning path.

D. To use your Acorn 500 with the app, follow these easy steps to configure your cleaner.










Make sure you have turned your cleaner on and that it is at the side of the pool.




OCOTN 600 Cleaning Modes

Once you have selected the cleaning mode in the last step, you will have 30 seconds before the motors start.

The bottom right LED in the array will turn green when this mode is activated.

Please place your cleaner in the water and ensure there are no air bubbles remaining inside before you let it sink to the bottom of the pool. It is important that there be no air trapped in the cleaner as this could impact the performance.



You have approximately 30 seconds before the motors engage. Place the cleaner in the water and completely submerge it before releasing it into the pool.



E. Manual program setting on the Acorn 500.

(2) To activate **FloorPlus[™]**, slide the switch to the right and allow it to return to the default position. Repeat this step. The bottom left LED in the array will turn green when this mode is activated.

Place the cleaner in the water and completely submerge it before releasing it into the pool.

1) To activate **TotalCleanTM** mode, slide the switch to the right and allow it to return to the default position.





(4) For **SmartClean[™]** mode, slide the switch to the right and allow it to return to the default position. Repeat this step. Do it again, and again (4 times in total) The top left LED in the array will turn green when this mode is activated. You have approximately 30 seconds before the motors engage.

When the cleaner has completed it's cycle, it will stop and the rectangular







